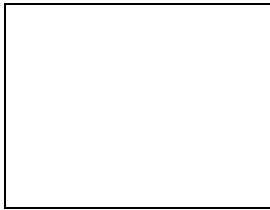


NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

NSS Unit helps to develop a sense of service, team spirit and dignity of labour. The various program conducted by the NSS have brought about a remarkable change in their outlook and their attitude towards life and society.

The curriculum of the NSS chapter, which was set up in 2010-2011, comprises of a gamut of events and activities undertaken by volunteers who have channelized their creativity and spirit of volunteerism to bring about meaningful change.

NSS unit of our College provides an opportunity of leadership development through social service. It is a platform where one can be a part of the programs conducted within and outside the college. We organize awareness campaigns, leadership camps, health camps and 7 days residential special camp every year.

The main aim of the NSS unit is to inculcate the leadership qualities and sensitize them towards the problems faced by our society today.

Enrolment drive conducted for students who wish to participate voluntarily to join the scheme. Orientation programme organised to orient the volunteers about the objectives, activities and also about the 7 days residential camp of NSS. Monsoon of 2019 became a menace for millions of families in India as the states of Maharashtra (Kolhapur) have been facing catastrophic floods since early July 2019, where nearly 40 districts were submerged underwater. There have been several charities working to help the flood-affected areas in Maharashtra by distributing emergency kits that will be helpful to those affected by the floods.

 CLOTHING: Bed sheets, Blankets, Mattresses, Sarees, Undergarments, Shirts, t-Shirts etc.
 OTHERS: Sanitary Napkins, Toiletries, Diapers, Candles, Mosquitoes Repellents, Tooth brush, Tooth Pastes, Food Plates etc.

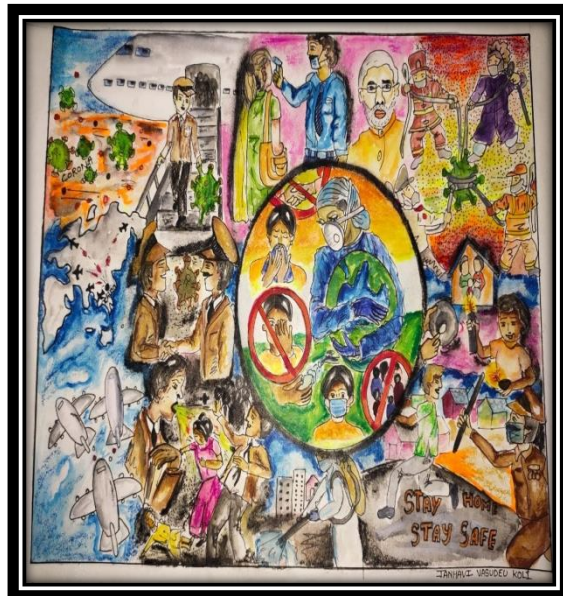
